If the total sum of the general taxes, other taxes, tariffs and compensations exceeds \$300, these taxes are payable in three installments, on:

First installment: April 2nd, 2014
Second installment: July 2nd, 2014
Third installment: October 2nd, 2014

How to pay your tax bill?

On your financial institution's website:

> To avoid paying interest and penalties, allow two business days prior to the due date indicated on your tax bill when making your payment. Make sure you enter the 19 digit matriculation number.

By automated teller machine or at the counter of most financial institutions:

> Allow two business days prior to the due date indicated on your tax bill to make your payment.

By mail:

> Payments sent by mail may be made by personal or certified cheque, money order or bank draft. Cheques and money orders must be made payable to "Municipality of Rawdon". Make sure that you write all of the matriculation numbers relevant to your payment on the back of your cheque or money order. When paying the first installment, we recommend that you enclose the cheques for the 2nd and 3rd installments along with the appropriate payment coupons.

At the Town Hall reception desk:

> Payments made at the Town Hall reception desk can be made with a debit card, cash, a personal or certified cheque, money order or bank draft.

Don't forget that your taxes must be paid in order to avoid any possible legal proceedings. For further information, please do not hesitate to contact us at 450 834-2596, ext. 7115.
