- Estimate the cost of the project²

Prizes will be awarded to the 3 best projects during the Environment Day festivities, **on May 25th 2019 at Collège Champagneur.**

The winner will see his/her project carried out. In 2018, the winning project proposed the construction and installation of bat houses!
